

## Introduction

Welcome to Mulligan's Golf Personal! Golf Personal is a useful and fun application that lets you record and analyze your golf game. Although this is the "Personal" edition, it will allow you to enter and report statistical information for as many players as you wish (limited for certain kinds of handicap tracking).

### What You Get

Mulligan's Golf Personal may be delivered to you in one of many different ways. You may receive the software by downloading via the internet, on diskettes, or on CD-ROM. However you receive it, the installation package will include:

- The Mulligan's Golf Personal installer application
- Mulligan's Golf Personal User's Guide - this manual, usually in electronic form
- Information about registering your copy of Golf Personal
- Information about getting handicapping plugins

### How to Get Help

We've tried to make Golf Personal as easy to use as possible. If you run into a problem, first try the Golf Personal Guide in the Help menu. You might try turning on balloon help for a while (there's a convenient button on the toolbar) and pointing to items in Golf Personal's windows that you don't understand.
